

# Monster Hand

**Tickets: 2**

**Location:** Yellow Pod, Room 204

<p><b>Prizes</b></p> <p>Lg Candy Bar: Orange ball                  Small prize: White ball</p>	<p><b>Volunteers</b></p> <p><b>Tickets &amp; Prizes:</b> One volunteer stays at the entry door, taking tickets, controlling entry, and exchanging prizes for colored balls.</p> <p><b>Harry:</b> One volunteer hides in the box playing Harry, the Monster Hand. <u>Put a glow stick outside the box when you run out of balls or need a break.</u></p>
<p><b>Key Rules</b></p> <p><b>Refill the ball bucket</b> only after all balls have been given out.</p>	<p><b>Running the Game</b></p> <p>Allow players to approach Harry’s box one at a time – remind them to knock on the box when they get there. Have them return to the ticket desk with the ball that Harry gave them and give them the appropriate prize. Put the ball in the returned ball bucket.</p> <p>Once the level of balls in the bucket reaches the tape, watch for Harry to put a glow stick outside of the box, indicating that he’s out of balls or needs a break. When that happens, tell the waiting players that there will be a short break, clear the room and close the door. Harry can leave the box and take a very brief (2 or 3 minutes) break at this time. Remove the cover from Harry’s ball bucket and dump all of the balls back into it, making sure they’re well mixed. Put the cover back on Harry’s bucket, load Harry back into the box, open the door, and resume play.</p> <p><b>Harry:</b> Put on the black sleeve, a disposable latex or latex-free glove, and one of the monster hands that fit well. Get in the box, and stay there until the other volunteer tells you there’s a break. Each time someone knocks on the box, use the monster hand to reach out the top door and hand out a ball. The hand can be spooky if you want, but don’t grab the players. You can knock on the box (don’t bang hard, it might fall on your head), make scratching or breathing noises, etc. but please, no screaming or yelling. Mysterious is fine but we don’t want to scare the younger kids. Please be gentle with the box, since the door, decorations, and fabric are easily damaged.</p>
