

New Parking Lot Procedures

Thanks to our School Advisory Council we have revised our parking lot procedures. We had a traffic engineer come and assess our current state and help us revise procedures to move traffic through the parking lot faster and safer.

Our road now has a yellow stripe to let drivers know that we now have a drop off lane and a passing/through lane. We are now allowing two lanes of traffic to pass in front of the school in the morning.

The morning drop off lane has been extended all the way up to the front of the handicapped spaces. Please be aware of parents parked in the handicapped spaces and allow them to merge into traffic. It is critical that all drivers follow rules involving handicapped spaces. Disabled parents and students have the right to these spaces.

The “One Way Only” signs and arrows on the road are in place for the flow of traffic and safety of our community. Please honor them.

Parents are no longer to use the East Parking Lot because parking there hinders the flow of traffic.

Please follow the procedures below:

- Drop off your student along the sidewalk and proceed to the passing/through lane. **Along the sidewalk** is the **only** drop off for parents.
- **Do not** drop your student off in the parking lot. If you walk your student to the building, you **must park** in the parking lot.
- Follow the direction of the traffic control people in front of the building and at the end of the drop off lane.
- If you pull in front of the handicapped spaces, **park in front of the spaces** not in the spaces **unless you have legal authorization to use handicapped spaces**.
- Follow the “One Way Only” signs and arrows on the road for traffic flow.
- The **small parking lot** is **reserved for staff** only. **Parents** are **not authorized** to use this lot unless directed by a staff member.
